



PUBLIC NOTICE

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A 40MPH SPEED LIMIT ON BARFORD ROAD, BLUNHAM

Reason for proposal: The speed limit is intended to act as a buffer between the existing 30mph and National Speed Limit sections of Barford Road.

Effect of the Order:

To introduce a 40mph Speed Limit on the following lengths of road in Blunham:-

1. Barford Road, from a point in line with the western side of the track located next to No. 76 Barford Road, where the existing 30mph/National Speed Limit signs are located and extending in a westerly direction for approximately 230 metres up to a point located approximately 20 metres west of the western property boundary belonging to No. 132 Barford Road.
