The construction team will be implementing traffic switches onto new road alignments to begin work on the northern and central sections of the new A421 flyover and to lower the A1 carriageway. Following this, excavation will take place to prepare for A1 traffic to pass beneath the new junction once it is complete.

To support these works, the following traffic switch changes will be made:

- The A421 eastbound free-flow link onto the A1 northbound will open to traffic
- The A421 westbound on-slip will open to traffic
- Bedford Road will be realigned and open to traffic

Our experts will offer an in-depth look at the upcoming traffic layout changes and answer questions that are submitted prior to the event.

Additionally, important details will be shared about the Black Cat roundabout closure scheduled for one weekend from 9pm Friday 15th August to 5am Monday 18th August 2025.
