The Green Infrastructure Plan will sit within the adopted Parish Neighbourhood Plan and will contain policies related to, for example, public footpaths, bridleways and open spaces. An initial workshop has enabled a map to be produced, together with a list of aspirations, which will form the basis of the Green Infrastructure Plan.

This final drop-in session will enable residents to see - first hand - the revised maps along with the aspirations that have been put forward during the consultation process. Attendees will have the opportunity to discuss their thoughts and add their own views on these with members of the Neighbourhood Plan Group and a Beds RCC green infrastructure officer.

Blunham is a great community surrounded by valuable countryside. It is also an area which is changing with increased pressure from development.
